golf course news

November is here and with it cooler temps and falling leaves. Growth is slowing on the course as our Bermuda hardens itself in anticipation of dormancy. This can be witnessed by the loss of color within the plant as starches are being stored in the roots versus the leaf blades this time of year. All in all, I'm very happy with how we look going into dormancy and I expect improved turf conditions come spring green up next year.

We have begun the process of edging the cart paths and spot spraying weeds on the course. Fall is an important time to get a jump on the weeds and we are concentrating our efforts to try to rid the course of dallisgrass, goosegrass (also known as silver crabgrass even though it is not a type of crabgrass), and crabgrass at this time. Other assorted broadleaf weeds are being addressed as well. After we get a new irrigation system installed, we will be able to apply a fall pre-emergent. Pre-emergents (fall and spring) are not effective if they cannot be watered in.

I am very pleased to report that our new pump station has arrived and been installed. This is the cornerstone of every successful golf course and the heart of the irrigation system. We are now prepared to install the rest of the circulatory system once funding has been achieved. The ability to accurately and reliably deliver water throughout the golf course is paramount and will undoubtedly elevate playing conditions to where we all want it to be.

On a side note, I would like to thank Dwight Halbrooks and Pat Rooney for the work they are doing on the new pump house. Also Rob Pearson for coming out and brush hogging the creek banks on numbers 2, 3, 4, and 5. Thank you gentlemen, your efforts are noticed and greatly appreciated.
