August was fairly typical for our location, hot and windy. We did receive a few timely rain events that helped us along and the golf course is in very good shape for this time of year. It would seem that the weather pattern this summer was conducive to grass weeds thriving. I have seen a significant increase in Poa, Crab, Goose, and Dallas grasses lately and in talking to my peers across the state, we're not alone in this affliction. We have been spraying post emergent herbicides when able but are considering for a pre-emergent application of Prodiamine on a granular fertilizer in for next year.

The City of Lawton is currently wrapping up the work they did to the sewer line that involved #3 and #8 and they are also fulfilling their obligation to add rip to the crossing on #17. The maintenance department has been busy keeping up with mowing demands and have been doing a lot of drainage repairs and sod work. Just a friendly reminder, our last greens aerification for the year will occur September 4 th and 5 th .
