April brings us the beginning of the *real* golf season and at LCC we are getting it started with a bang. On Wednesday, April 8, we will be hosting a Callaway demo day from 2:00 - 6:00 on the driving range, followed by the Masters draw at 6:00 in the ballroom. At the demo day you can hit all of the latest Callaway clubs with different shafts. If you are interested in making a purchase that day, you will find that you will be able to get a price that is competitive with any place else. Then at the Masters draw, which has always been a fun event, you can purchase a player for \$100, with the possibility of a great return for your investment. You will also be helping to support the MGA and their special projects for the golf course.

We have recently received some Titleist drivers and fairway woods that you can demo. These are also priced to sell.

April is also the month that the crew gets busy on the golf course. The initial treatment of pre-emergence and weed killer has already been applied. The greens are being fertilized the first week of April, with the fertilization of the tee boxes, fairways and playable rough scheduled for late April or early May. The deep core aeration of the greens (along with the driving range tee area) will happen Monday, May 4. Late May or early June will be the time for the second application for the fence-to-fence weed control.

The MGA 4-man Scramble will be Sunday, April 19. LCC will be hosting two school tournaments this month. The All-City Junior High School tournament is slated for Thursday, April 2, and the Elgin Junior High tournament will tee off Thursday, April 9. We will also be the site for the Kenneth Bridges Great Plains Technology Center scramble Monday, April 6.

board minutes

The board met in a 2 1/2 hour session on March 24. Considering the effects on the upcoming membership drive, the board decided in a 5 to 4 vote to "freeze" the sale of all golf passes. The future of the golf pass will be considered in the June board meeting after the success of the membership drive is known.

The board also examined wait staff gratuities. LCC has been adding a 15% gratuity on all food and beverage sales, with that amount being placed in a "tip pool" which has been shared by each member of the wait staff based on the number of hours each worked during the pay period. Any additional gratuity amount was paid directly to the server. After a survey of six other country clubs in this area, it was recommended that in an effort to attract and retain the highest caliber of wait staff, LCC should raise the gratuity to 18% with the entire amount of the gratuity being paid to the server. An additional gratuity can still be indicated, and a provision will be made to indicate a member's opinion that the service received did not warrant an 18% gratuity. The motion passed in a unanimous vote.

The board also voted to explore the possibility of providing a fireworks show on July 4. {810}
