In their monthly meeting July 14, the board voted to cancel the golf pass program effective July 31. The board also voted to revise our reciprocity agreement with Ft. Sill Golf Club. Beginning August 1, any Ft. Sill Golf Club member wishing to play our course will have to verify their membership at Ft. Sill, and pay the normal green fee of \$52.00 plus tax. **{756}**

Last month we erroneously reported that the board voted to hire a full-time qualified greens superintendent. In fact, the board voted to form the search committee to explore the possibility of hiring a full-time qualified greens superintendent. Also, we failed to mention that in June the board voted to revise the club's Rules and Regulations (5.7 a.) which states: Jogging, walking, bicycling, skating, rollerblading and walking of dogs are not permitted on the golf course or cart paths at any time. The revised rule now states: Jogging, walking, bicycling, skating, rollerblading and walking of dogs on the golf course or cart paths must be approved in advance by the pro shop.
